Thus, when we get down to the root of our present-day problems in head-on collision with the "other," one asserts that the individual is sacred; that every human soul is endowed with a divine, God-given personality. The other maintains that we are all mere cells in the great body politic and that we cannot so much as touch the individual rights of another. This latter concept
