

## **Key Names**


- •Syngman Rhee, ROK's first president, held office 12 years, 1948 1960
- Park Chung Hee, former general, gained power through a military coup, held office 18 years, 1961 to 1979, when he was assassinated by his own security chief.


## **Key Names**

- •Chun Doo Hwan, former general, president from 1980 1987, subsequently convicted of treason.
- •Kim Dae Jung, repeated opposition presidential contender from the Kwangju region. Finally elected in 1997.
- •5.18 Resistance or 5.18 Uprising. The name is based on the date it began: May 18, 1980.



















