This is what the freshmen's dollars can do. We who are fortunate enough to attend the university here --- are we big enough to want to help these needy students who are struggling for their education? What do you freshmen, who dug in your pockets, say? Yours is the power to lighten the burden of a struggling student, or if you choose to add to your personal pleasures.

(con't from P. 1) do to help the enemy aliens of the Pacific Coast and the Japanese in particular.

Returning from the California conference, Professor Schmoe will visit the Missoula concentration camps to aid in the hearings of the Japanese who are being held there.
