71 students or 29% answered yes.
119 students or 49% answered no.
15 students or 6% answered partially.
39 students or 16% did not know.

3. What approximate funds do you have available to continue your college education?

Out of the group of 214 students, 128 listed the amount of funds that they had available. The average amount available for these 128 students was \$ 376.00.

10 students had \$1000.00 to \$3000.00
19 students had 500.00 to 1000.00
36 students had 200.00 to 500.00
32 students had 100.00 to 200.00
17 students had less than \$100.00
14 students had an unknown or no amount of funds.

4. Would you be able to continue your college education if supplementary funds were available?

163 students or 75% answered yes.
9 students or 4% answered no.
45 students or 21% answered did not know.
