The Regents, in response to requests of Presidents of west coast Universities, approved the acceptance of a limited number of American born persons of Japanese ancestry as students but under the following conditions:

1. That they be citizens of the United States;
2. That they be self-supporting;
3. That they pay non-resident tuition;
4. That they have individual clearance through the Federal Bureau of Investigation;
5. That they be in good standing in the institution from which they come;
6. That they be transferred subject to the approval of the Commandant of the 12th Naval District;
7. That they be not eligible to attend classes the subject matter of which is of a confidential nature.
